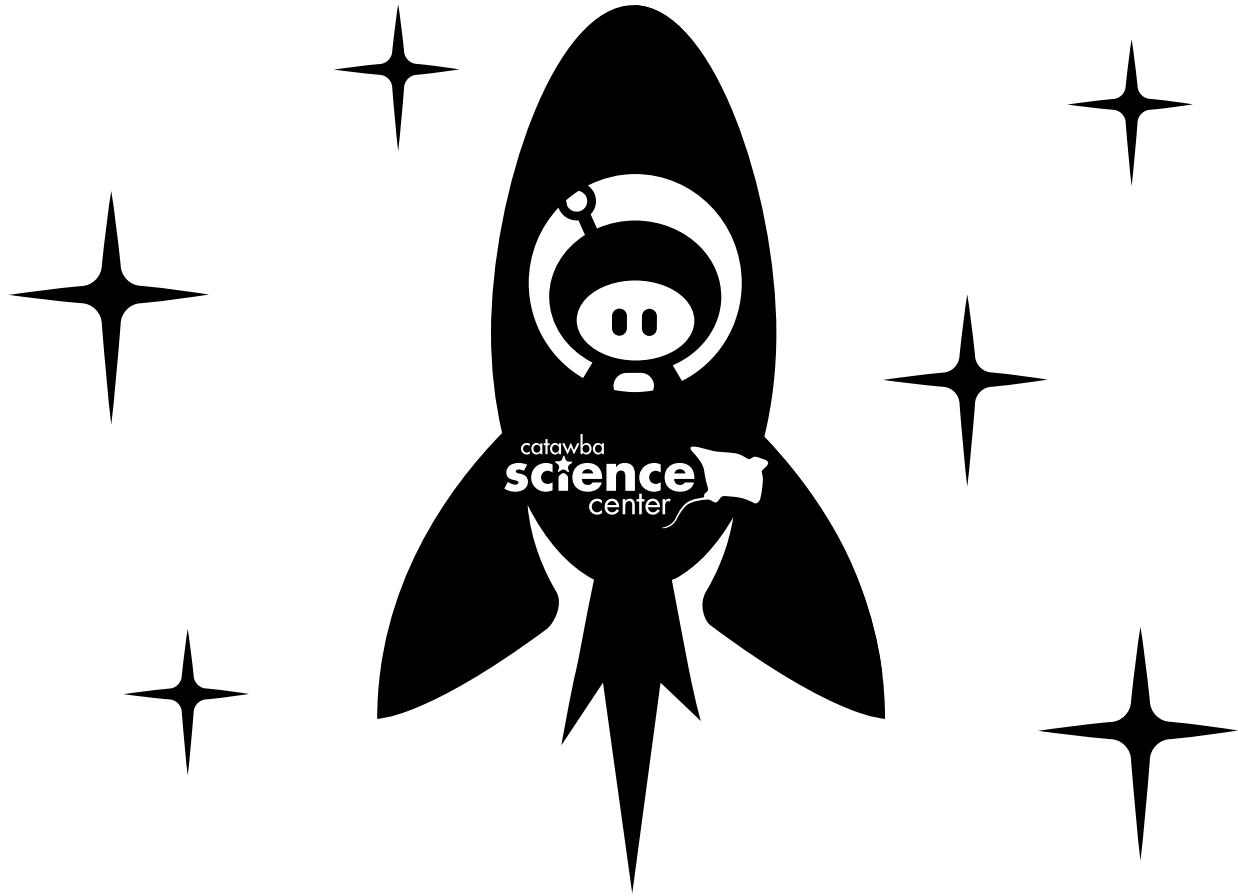


BLAST-OFF ... into a new year of engaging, preschool science programs at Catawba Science Center!

**September 15
Rainbow Riders**

Who is ROY G BIV? What makes a rainbow? Discover the colors of the rainbow and learn how sun and rain work together to create magical colors. Make your own handprint rainbow.

**October 13
Spiders, Insects & Snakes, Oh My!**

Explore the world of insects, spiders and snakes. Meet "Rosie" the tarantula, hissing roaches and other CSC creatures. Make your own insect and snake, and spin a spider web.

**November 10
Amazon Adventure**

Who lives in the rainforest? Does it always rain in the rainforest? Find out as you partake in an amazing Amazon Adventure. Make your own rainstick.

**December 15
Arctic Exploration**

What do animals do in the winter? Can polar bears float on ice? Explore the animals of the Arctic and Antarctic regions. Walk like a penguin and have a taste of "snow."

**January 12
Be a Planet**

Is there life on Mars? How many rings does Saturn have? Which planet is the hottest? Find out as you become an astronaut and explore the planets. All astronauts will make a rocket to take home.

**February 9
The Heart & Other Body Parts**

How does your body work? How do you think? How do you breathe? Find out how your body works as you become a body mirror.

**March 9
How Does The Wind Blow?**

Children will learn about the principles of air and wind. Discover how wind makes things move. Make your own kite to take home and fly.

**April 13
Earth Superheroes**

How do trees help us? Where does the garbage go? Learn ways to help save the earth, and conserve water, land and energy. Learn how to recycle and receive a recycling awareness certificate.

**May 11
B is for Butterflies**

Discover the wonders of butterflies. Is a butterfly always a butterfly? Put on some wings and pretend you are one, too. Create a colorful butterfly to take home.

Catawba Science Center is happy to present another year of engaging, educational programs to inspire young scientists. The Preschool Science Program is open to all children ages 3-5. Classes will be held at CSC, Tuesdays, from 10:30 until 11:15 a.m. Preschoolers get their hands dirty and their minds piqued by exploring simple science concepts through play, crafts and demonstrations.

Cost is \$8 per child for CSC members, \$15 per child for nonmembers. **Sign up for the year at a cost of \$58 for members, \$116 for nonmembers.** Accompanying adults are free. Pre-payment and registration required to reserve your space, which is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.
