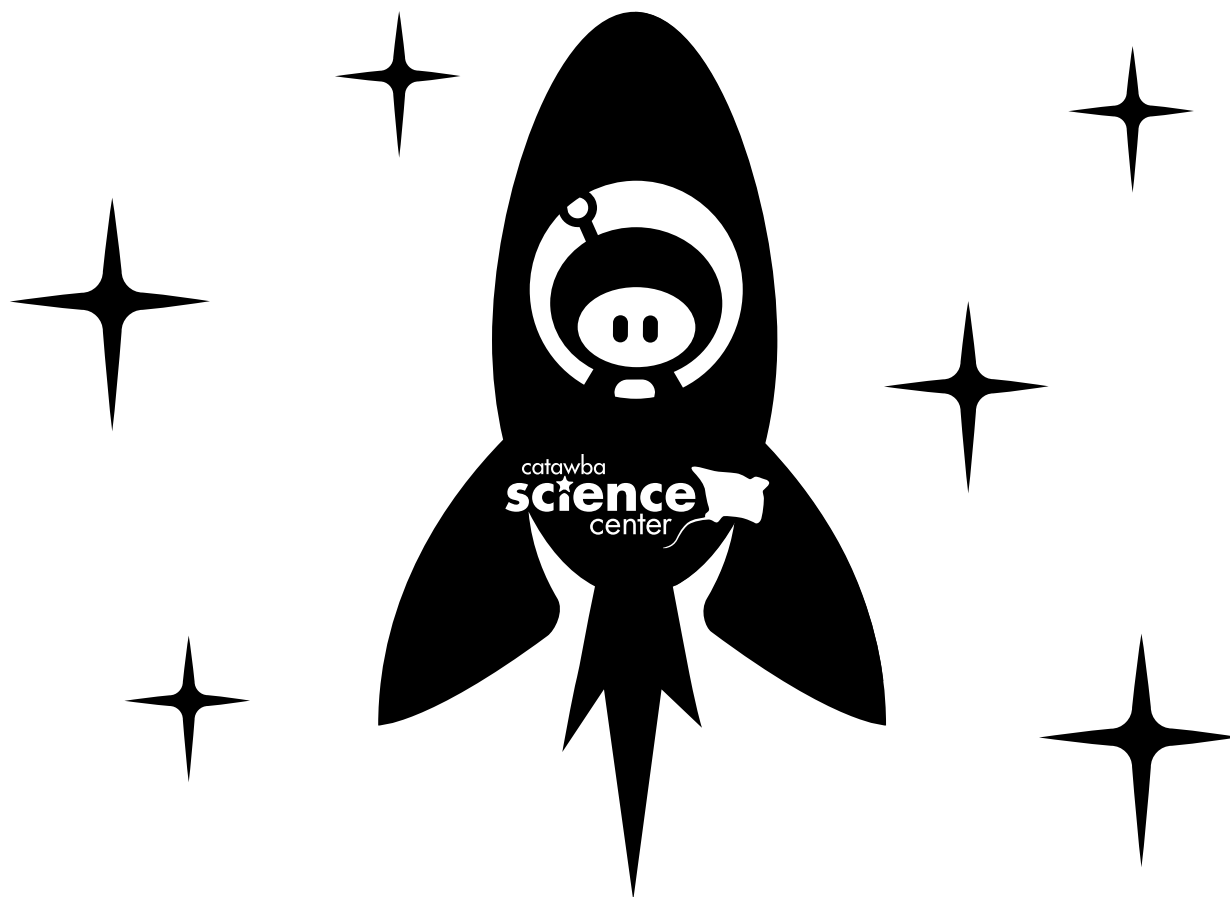


BLAST-OFF ... into a new year of engaging & educational preschool science programs at Catawba Science Center



The 2011-12 Preschool Science Program is open to all children, ages 3 to 5.

Classes will be held at CSC on Tuesdays, from 10:30 until 11:15 a.m.

September 13
Creepy Crawlies

Explore the world of insects, spiders and snakes. Meet "Rosie" the tarantula, hissing roaches and other CSC creatures. Watch a roach race, make a snake and spin a spider web.

October 11
3-2-1- ... Blast Off

Is there life on Mars? How many rings does Saturn have? Which planet is the hottest? Find out as you become an astronaut. Take a journey around the universe and explore all of our planets. All astronauts will make a rocket to take home.

November 15
Rainbow Riders

Who is ROY G BIV? What makes a rainbow? Find out as you discover the colors of the rainbow. Learn how the sun and rain work together to create magical colors. Make your own unique rainbow.

December 13
Arctic Exploration

What do animals do in the winter? Can polar bears float on ice? Explore the animals of the Arctic and Antarctic regions. Walk like a penguin and have a taste of "snow."

January 17
African Adventures

Travel the African Savannah and learn all about this continent's beautiful animals. Roar like a lion and run like a cheetah. Students will create their own African Savannah and discover who is living there.

February 14
Dinosaur Discovery

Discover dinosaurs big and small by examining fossils and learning the difference between an herbivore and a carnivore. Make your own T-Rex tooth to take home.

March 13
Radical Rainforest

Does it always rain in the rainforest? Have you ever eaten foods from the rainforest? Find out as you travel to a magical place where unique animals can be found high and low. Students will make their own rainsticks and world tree.

April 17
Green Thumbs

Learn what it takes to make your garden grow and study the life cycle of a sunflower. Students will plant their own mini-garden to take home.

May 15
B is for Butterflies

Discover the wonders of butterflies. Is a butterfly always a butterfly? Find out by learning the butterfly's life cycle. Put on some wings and pretend you are a butterfly, too. Create a colorful butterfly to take home.

Catawba Science Center is happy to present another year of engaging, educational programs to inspire young scientists. The Preschool Science Program is open to all children ages 3-5. Classes will be held at CSC, Tuesdays, from 10:30 until 11:15 a.m. Preschoolers get their hands dirty and their minds piqued by exploring simple science concepts through play, crafts and demonstrations.

Cost is \$8 per child for CSC members, \$15 per child for nonmembers. **Sign up for the year at a cost of \$58 for members, \$116 for nonmembers.** Accompanying adults are free. Pre-payment and registration required to reserve your space, which is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.
